Carol decided that the only services that would be held was a celebration of life that she wanted to be at. She firmly believed that if others got to say stories about her

she wanted to say stories about them too. The Palliative Care team were so wonderful that when it was decided that it wasn't in her best interest health wise to leave the hospital, they went well above and beyond their duties and helped arrange everything so her celebration was the best it could be. It was everything she wanted and even better.

She always had the most visitors in each day and had the best food brought in for her too. Not many people can say they had steak while in the hospital. A special thank you to Diane, Mandy, and Lori for alternating their nights so that mom was never alone in those last 3 weeks.
